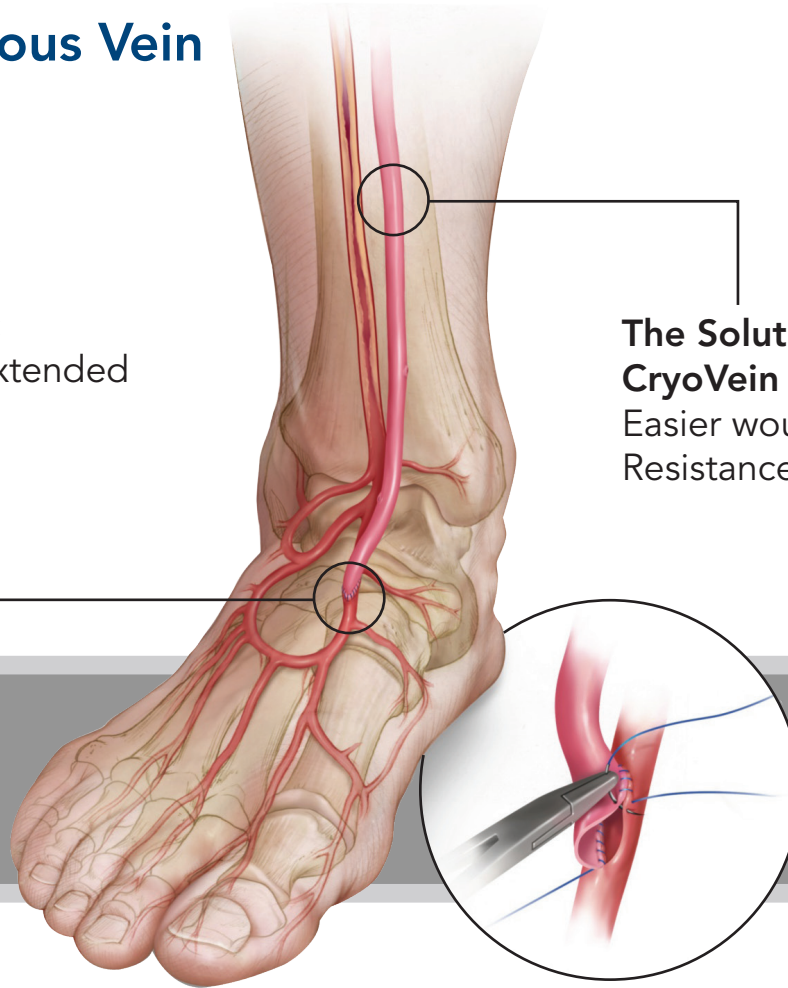

The Challenge:

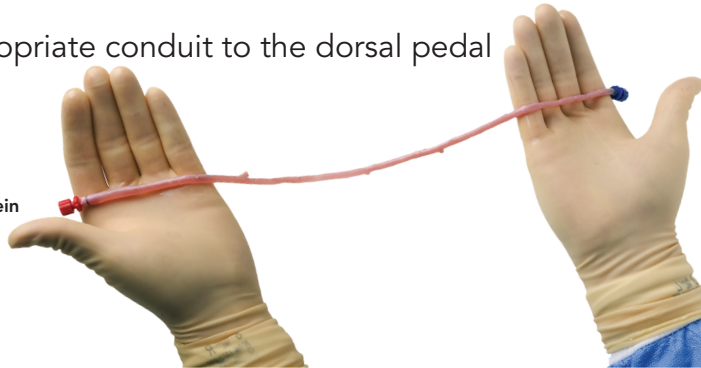
Bypass to crural or pedal vessels in the absence of suitable autologous saphenous vein remains a major challenge.³

- > Grafting to the pedal arteries can greatly increase the risk of wound infection throughout the limb.⁶
- > Prosthetic conduits in this indication yield inferior results and are prone to infection in the presence of ulcers.²

The Solution:

The only appropriate conduit to the dorsal pedal artery is **vein**.⁷
