# Maintenance and Service

- 1. Call your local CryoLife Representative or CryoLife at 1-888-427-9654
- 2. Your CryoLife Representative will assist you in completing the necessary forms and agreements
- 3. After the completion of the approval process, CryoLife will ship your hospital a freezer
- 4. The hospital will need to order in advance two LS-160 liquid nitrogen supply tanks to arrive a couple of days before the freezer
- 5. A CryoLife Representative will install the new freezer, program the CryoFreezer monitor, and train hospital personnel on the equipment

### **Hospital Responsibilities:**

- Supply the liquid nitrogen
- Check the temperature & liquid nitrogen levels of the CryoFreezer daily on the digital display and manually once a week with a measuring device

### **CryoLife Responsibilities:**

- Annual preventative maintenance performed by CryoLife Representative
- CryoLife Technical Support Services Representative is available 24 hours, 365 days a year at 1-800-438-8285
